

INFORMATION CLAUSE FOR BIDDERS PARTICIPATING IN THE TENDER

MARKED „SUCHA 44”

Based on articles 13 section 1-2 and 14 section 1-2 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (hereinafter referred to as "GDPR"), we hereby inform that:

1. The administrator of your personal data is: Sucha Development spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością with its registered office in Warsaw, at Plac Bankowy 2, 00-095 Warsaw (hereinafter also referred to as the "**Company**").
2. The Company can be contacted regarding the processing of personal data via e-mail: biuro@fprop.com.pl or in writing to the address of the registered office (Plac Bankowy 2, 00-095 Warsaw).
3. Your personal data will be processed by the Company for the following purpose:
 - 1) Consideration of your offer submitted in the tender and taking actions prior to the conclusion of the contract related to the tender for the sale of property, aimed at concluding a contract with the Company, as well as for the performance of this contract (article 6 section 1 point b) of the GDPR).
 - 2) for the realization of the legitimate interest of the administrator in the form of establishing, defending and asserting claims, for archival (evidential) purposes, which are the realization of the legitimate interest of securing information in the event of a legal need to prove facts, to demonstrate the fulfillment of obligations (the basis of article 6 section 1 point f) GDPR).

In addition, your personal data will be processed by the Company on the basis of your consent, to the extent and for the purpose specified in the content of the consent (article 6 section 1 point a).

The purposes and legal bases for processing your personal data in the case of a representative/agent of the Bidder or another person whose personal data has been provided by the Bidder (in particular, name, PESEL, phone number, email address, position) as indicated in the documents submitted to the Company in the context of proceedings for the sale of property by the Bidder, apply the purposes and legal bases for processing specified in point 3, as well as an additional purpose and legal basis for processing: taking actions prior to the conclusion of a contract between the Company and the Bidder, aimed at concluding the contract, particularly conducting proceedings for the sale of property, as well as for the performance of this contract (legal basis from article 6 section 1 point b) of the GDPR).

4. Your personal data will be kept for the time necessary to fulfill the purposes specified in point 3, i.e.:
 - 1) for the consideration of the offer submitted by you, to take action at your request before concluding a contract, in particular for the purpose related to the tender for the sale of property, aimed at concluding a contract with the Company,
 - 2) for the period of time necessary to take actions aimed at concluding a contract, as well as for the time during which regulations require the Company to keep the data,
 - 3) in terms of the performance of the contract concluded with the bidder - for the duration of the contract until its completion and settlement, as well as for the time during which the law orders us to store data for the Company,

- 4) w zakresie zabezpieczenia ewentualnych roszczeń, ustalenia, obrony i dochodzenia roszczeń - przez okres przedawnienia roszczeń wynikających z przepisów prawa, a także przez czas, w którym przepisy nakazują nam przechowywać dane,
- 5) for archival (evidential) purposes, which are the realization of our legitimate interest in securing information in case of a legal need to prove facts, to demonstrate the fulfillment of obligations,

and, in addition, in the case of an attorney/representative (or other person whose personal data has been provided by the bidder) in terms of taking action prior to the conclusion of a contract between the Company and the bidder, aimed at concluding a contract, in particular, to conduct a tender for the sale of property, as well as for the purpose of executing the contract with the bidder, - until the existence of the Company's legitimate interests constituting the basis for this processing, as well as for the time during which regulations order the Company to store the data.

5. You have the right to request access to your personal data and to receive a copy of it, the right to request their rectification (correction), deletion, or restriction of processing of your personal data, as well as the right to data portability.
In the case of giving voluntary consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of data at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
In addition, you have the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
6. Your personal data may be shared with the following recipients and categories of recipients: the entity exercising ownership rights over the Company, the Company's contractors with whom it cooperates in its daily operations and in the conduct of the tender for the sale of property, entities engaged in postal or courier services, entities engaged in payment activities, entities engaged in insurance or banking activities, business information bureaus, institutions, authorities, entities authorized by law, such as. police, tax authorities, court, prosecutor's office, customs authorities, Energy Regulatory Office, the Office of Competition and Consumer Protection (UOKiK), or others, as well as our subcontractors acting on our behalf (entities processing personal data to the extent indicated by the Company), i.e. companies providing us with consulting, advisory, auditing services, law firms, IT companies, as well as subcontractors of the above recipients and subcontractors.
7. Your personal data may be transferred to a third country (i.e., a country outside the European Economic Area, hereinafter: EEA), however, such data shall be transferred only to those third countries that, in the opinion of the European Commission, provide an adequate level of protection for such data.
8. The Company in the processing of data referred to above will not make decisions by automated methods and your data will not be profiled.
